

OA 100 # GROUP CONSCIENCE MEETING

December 1, 2025

Nan called the meeting to order at 9 PM Eastern Time. She read the minutes from last month and they were approved.

Sue S. gave the Treasurer's Report for the two accounts – the bank and PayPal. Sue transferred \$300 to the bank to pay Bluehost. The bank transfer fee of \$5.25 plus the web hosting fee of \$539.64 brought total expenses to \$554.77. The remaining bank balance after expenses is \$17.37. The remaining PayPal balance is \$561.14. The total ending balance of the two accounts is \$578.51.

Donations are slowing down. Sue asked everyone to contribute a couple of dollars so donations to OA.org and the Virtual Region can resume because the cut off total balance to make donations is \$700 in order to keep a prudent reserve of \$200 in the bank.

Sue explained how to donate stating that if you go to the OA100pounders.org website you get the option to pay by credit or debit card or through PayPal but you don't have to set up a PayPal account. Sue confirmed that recurring contributions can be made there as well.

Sue made the motion to accept the Treasurer Report and Lynn seconded the motion.

Nan turned the floor over to Lynn. Vacancies for trusted servants were: Tuesday moderator; Speaker Getter Coordinator and Speaker Getters Friday and Saturday. She explained Speaker Getters set up 12 - 13 speakers over a 3-month period and don't need to be present on a specific day or time -- that it can be done on their own schedule.

Lynn asked for a vote that all trusted servants be required to avoid conflicts because they interfere with carrying the message. Trusted servants must demonstrate living and practicing the steps, principles and traditions. Nan asked for a vote and the motion passed 9-4. All coordinators will share this as they bring on new trusted servants and it will be posted periodically in chat as a reminder by the meeting coordinator..

Joanie brought up the issue of shortening the script which will be added to the January meeting agenda.

Sue S. announced that Virtual Intergroup meeting is December 21st at 3:00 PM Eastern Time. Elections for a new chair, vice chair, committee chairs and a secretary are scheduled. Anyone interested can attend the meeting. For information get in touch with Sue at 516-721-0816.
